The Egypt Exploration Society has been the home of British Egyptology since 1882. Our globally significant collections include unique archaeological archives and the Oxyrhynchus Papyri, containing unparalleled ancient literature and biblical manuscripts.

This precious heritage is at risk. Our onsite archival materials are threatened by structural damage. Access issues jeopardise our mission to care for these collections and promote learning from them; our inaccessible building creates barriers to research and engagement activities, while the Oxyrhynchus Papyri are stored offsite with little opportunity for public access.

Building the Future will save our irreplaceable collections by transforming our premises into an accessible, innovative, and sustainable heritage centre.
